Area wide emergencies can come to us in various forms such as:

- Earthquakes
- Wildfires
- Floods
- Long term power, gas, and water service failure
- Winter weather

The above examples are not all inclusive, but just some of the circumstances we should prepare for. First Responders will not be available to us if roads are closed or impassable. Some estimates indicate it may take First Responders 72 hours plus to reach us with relief. We should prepare to be self sufficient while waiting for needed help.

The following files are prepared to help us have a basic understanding on how to prepare for area wide emergencies. You can download the files to your computer and print them for your families to study. The files are prepared to help you understand necessary steps for emergency preparedness.

Our community is divided into 4 blocks with a Block Captain in each block. The Block Captain map will indicate which block you are in. Block Captains are to provide a quick assessment of damages and needed help in their block. You can help by familiarizing yourself with the 4 color Status Program. The gathered information will be provided to an Area Leader, District Leader and to Draper City for necessary help when available.
